



General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) Statement

The Blessed Holy Family Catholic Academy Trust is committed to protecting and respecting the rights of the individual. As such the Trust Board Directors, local governing body, members and employees across all of the Schools within the Trust are mindful of their obligations under General Data Protection Regulation (“the GDPR”) and other data protection legislation. Our Trust is a Multi Academy Trust of 4 Schools. Each School has systems in place that are compliant with legislation.

We believe that everyone has rights with regard to the way in which their personal data is used and stored. During the course of our activities we will collect, store and process personal information about a number of different groups of people and we recognise that we need to treat it in an appropriate and lawful manner.

The type of information that we may be required to handle include details of job applicants, current, past and prospective employees, pupils, parents/carers and other members of pupils’ families, directors, local governors, suppliers and other individuals that we communicate with. The information that we hold is subject to legal safeguards as outlined in legislation. specified in the GDPR and other legislation.

Each school has a named Data Protection Officer for responsible for ensuring the school is compliant with Data Protection Legislation and who serves as the central point of contact for all data requests.
